# THE GREAT FEAST OF PENTECOST

### THE HOLY SPIRIT COMES

Fifty days after Pascha, we celebrate Pentecost—the day when the Holy Spirit came down from heaven and filled the Apostles with power, wisdom, and courage. Before this, the Apostles were afraid and didn't know what to do. But when the Holy Spirit came, they were filled with joy and began to speak in many languages, sharing the Good News of Jesus with everyone!



The Monday after Pentecost Sunday is called "Monday of the Holy Spirit" as it is the dedicated Feast Day of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit helps us —giving us strength to love, to forgive, to pray, and to live like Jesus every day.

> upon you" - Acts 1:8




# SAINT STORIES - St. BARTHOLOMEW

# CRAFT HOLY SPIRIT WIND SPINNER

#### Materials:

- Paper plate
- Markers/crayons
- Scissors
- String or yarn
- Flame shapes (cut from paper or felt)
- Dove shapes (cut from paper or felt)

#### **Instructions:**

- Color the plate with red, orange, and yellow. The colors of Pentecost.
- Working from the outer edge cut the plate into a spiral shape leaving a 2 inch circle in the middle.
- Glue paper flames and a dove at the center or edges.
- Add words like "Holy Spirit," "Peace," "Love," "Joy."
- Use string or yarn to hang it up to spin and remind you that the Holy Spirit is always moving!
